The meeting was concerned with the Society competitions:



The **Silver Medal** for a 12 sheet entry was won by **Frank Simpson** for his display of “**Braunschweig, (Brunswick) Germany.**”



The **Bronze Medal** for a 9 sheet display was won by **Paul Elliot** for his display of “**Scenery, Fauna & Flora of Norway on stamps in booklets.**”



The **John Burgess Thematic Trophy** for a 12 sheet display on a thematic theme was won by **Graham Harker** for his display of the “**SS Great Western.**”

The 16 members present enjoyed the opportunity to look at the frames and to adjudicate on the winners.

In the second part of the evening **President Brian Asquith** showed a display of Postal History of the **Levant**. As the Turkish Post Office was not recognised by

the UPU postage from the country was not allowed. Therefore a number of other post offices were set up to deal with mail – British, German, Italian, Russian, Roumanian, Austrian and French. Brian showed covers from each of the post offices each with their individual marks. The material was very varied and included military censorship marks.
