President Paul Elliot opened the meeting at 19.45 hours attended by 18 members and introduced **ADRIAN JONES** and invited him to present his display on **KENYA, UGANDA AND TANGANYIKA**.



Adrian had worked in the Kenya Police Force and his interest in the stamps had developed through living in the country for many years. He also had a wealth of stories to tell as well as details about the stamps.

He described the geography of the countries as well as their history. His display showed stamps, postcards, covers and photographs. He had a variety of stamps – complete sheets, blocks, miniature sheets, overprints, errors, forgeries, colour missing, incorrect perfs. and revenue stamps. There were a variety of covers including official mail going into a special camp set up in the Kenya Rift Valley to detain Palestinians.

The viewing of the frames were enjoyed by the members and the meeting closed at 21.30 hours.
