Frank Simpson displayed a series of covers of **Brunswick, Germany**, from the Napoleonic period to 1860.



Chris Board showed three sets of postal stationary cards produced in the 1920's in **South Africa**.



Graham Harker, as it was Armistice Day, showed Great Britain commemorative stamps/miniature sheets of the **Less We Forget** series and the recently issued stamps of the **First World War**.



David Milsted showed a number of letters and covers from **The Tower of London** including a spoof invitation to the annual washing of the lions!



Ian Nutley's display concerned The Chicago Flight of the Graf Zeppelin in 1933. There were a number of covers related to the flight.



Chris Hitchen showed covers of the **French Railways** in the nineteenth century.



Brian Asquith displayed stamps of the **Turkish Aviation Fund** between 1926-36. The stamps were produced to raise money and to promote aviation.



Paul Percival showed stamps of **Aitutaki**, part of the Cook Islands, from 1903-73 and **Ajman**, United Arab Emirates, from 1964-69.



Alan Holverson displayed stamps of **Austria** from 1851.
