1. **Chris Hitchen – Recouvrement** – the French Debt Collection business;
2. **Paul Elliot – Rescue** – trains saved following the Beeching cuts.
3. **Terry Page – Russian Revolution** – postcards and stamps;
4. **Graham Harker – Railway, Great Western** – postcards, stamps and covers;
5. **John Schofield – Rhodesia & Nyasaland** – stamps of the Federation 1954-1963 plus stamps of the separate countries before and after the Federation;
6. **Brian Asquith – Replacement Post Office Services** – set up to counter the 1971 Post Office Strike;

7. **David Taylor - Reichsarbeitsdienst** - the female section of the German Labour Service;
8. **Michael Harris - Re-enactment Covers** - 5 Australian Covers of various events such as the First Mail by Packhorse.
9. **Chris Board - South African Railways** - a series of postcards;
10. **Paul Percival - Countries beginning with the letter 'R'** - stamps of Rhodesia, Roumania, Russia and Ruanda.
11. **Frank Simpson - Reisender schrieben in Die Heimat** - travellers writing home to Goslar, Germany.
12. **Richard West - Royal Mail Retail Stamp Booklets** - books with windows sold by both post offices and stationers.
